Sivells Testing:

PreKindergarten - CLI (3 times per year) & IStation (beginning of each month)

Kindergarten - DRA, TPRI, TKEA and Imagine Math (3 times per year) and IStation (beginning of each month)

First Grade - DRA, TPRI, Imagine Math (3 times per year) and IStation (beginning of each month)

Second Grade - DRA, TPRI, Imagine Math, ESTAR (3 times per year) and IStation (beginning of each month)

Description of Tests:

CLI - Children's Learning Institute (CLI) strongly recommends the use of assessment data to help early childhood teachers understand student skill levels and individualize instruction to support areas in which students are at-risk for falling significantly behind.

DRA - The Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA) is an individually administered assessment of a child's reading capabilities. It is a tool to be used by instructors to identify a students reading level, accuracy, fluency and comprehension.

IStation - IStation is a computer adapted reading program that measures student growth with diagnostic and screening programs. Its web-based reporting provides formative insight to guide instructional decision-making and intervention strategies for all students through interactive learning activities.

TPRI - The TPRI is a highly reliable early reading assessment designed to identify the reading development of students in kindergarten through third grade. This diagnostic instrument is an easy to use one-on-one assessment which helps teachers provide targeted instruction so that students improve as readers.

ESTAR - The Elementary Students in Texas: Algebra Ready (ESTAR) is a universal screener that is a formative assessment system administered to students in grades 2-8 to support instructional decisions. It is based on algebra-readiness skills.

Imagine Math - Imagine Math is a computer based diagnostic assessment that is given at the beginning, middle and end of year
