This week we are learning:

Reading and Language Arts: (Genre: Informational) Students will identify the main idea in a text and distinguish it from the topic. Students will describe the order of events or ideas in a text.

Phonics/Spelling Pattern: Students will use common syllabication patterns to decode words including r controlled vowel words (ir, er, ur).

Math: Students will describe and identify fractional parts.

Science: Students will identify factors in the environment, including temperature and precipitation, that affect growth and behavior such as migration, hibernation, and dormancy of living things

Social Studies: Students will interpret information on maps and globes using basic map elements such as title, orientation and legend/map keys. Students will create maps to show places and routes within the home, school, and community.

Spelling Words: burn, germ, shirt, stir, surf, bird, curb, girl, hurt, her

Sight Words: kind, draw, bus, can't, tell, cat, take, dad, hide, dog

Homework:

2nd grade students need to practice spelling and sight words each night. Students also need to read at least 20 minutes each night. They will have a book in their book bags. They will have a spelling test and sight word test every Friday. Students also need to practice math fact fluency daily, they will be tested in timed minute tests.
